Cookies

In terms of the HTTP protocol, a cookie is a small block of data which a web server sends to a browser, which then stores it on the user's computer. The browser then sends this data back to the server on each subsequent visit to the same server. Cookies are commonly used to distinguish individual users (but cannot identify a specific user), and to store user preferences, etc.

Although most browsers support cookies, other simpler browsers (e.g. on mobile devices) may not. Moreover, cookies can be disabled in most browsers. You therefore have the option of choosing your own cookie preferences. (Source: https://cs.wikipedia.org/wiki/HTTP_cookie)
